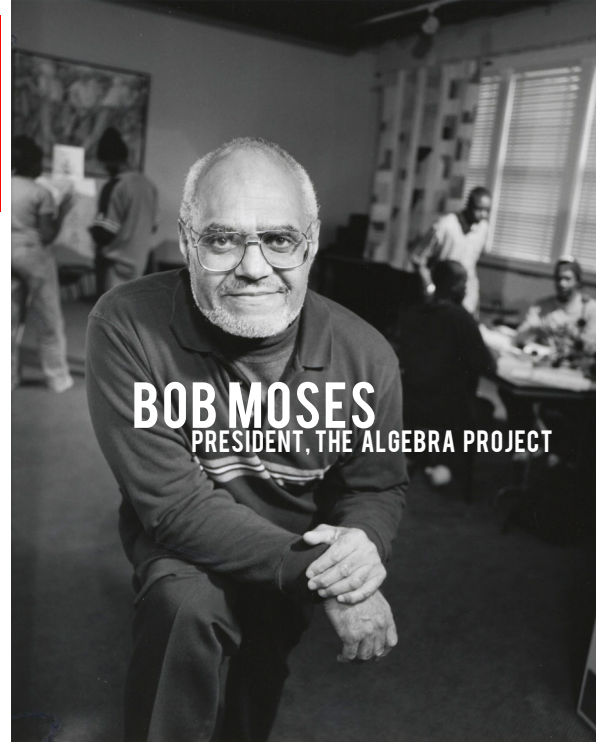

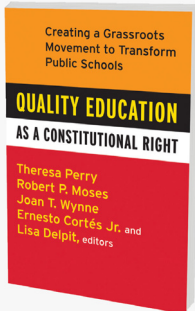
of the nation's children. Dr. Moses will sign his new book. All royalties are donated to the Young People's Project.
